WE CANNOT PROVIDE SAME DAY ADOPTIONS

It is Greyhaven's policy to ensure all adoption procedures are followed, which include reviewing applications, performing reference checks, scanning our database for a suitable companion bird, contacting you, arranging a home visit and after all criteria has been met, placing a bird in your home.

Greyhaven is strongly committed to the welfare of the birds relinquished to us. In order to assist you in understanding our adoption program, we have provided the following information,

- All information requested on the adoption application is vital in successfully determining the best match between you and a companion bird. Once you have completed the application and submitted it to Greyhaven, we will begin the adoption process.
- We will contact you to arrange the "initial home visit". The initial home visit serves a dual purpose, it allows you to ask in-depth questions about the bird you are interested in, and it allows us to determine whether your choice is appropriate for your environment and family. An example would be, if you lived in an apartment a Conure might not be the right choice for you as they are well known for their vocalizations and can be quite loud. We would then suggest a more appropriate bird. *All members of the family should participate in this visit.*
- At the conclusion of our visit, we will be able to determine whether a bird is for you and whether we should proceed with the adoption process. Please keep in mind, a bird is not for everyone and we have a responsibility to make the appropriate decision for the well-being of the individuals concerned as well as the bird considered for adoption.
- If the above criteria has been met, arrangements will be made to attend your home with your new companion bird. We will provide you with a list of your companion's likes and dislikes such as favourite foods and toys, what makes him/her anxious, safety precautions, health care concerns and much more.

An Adoption Agreement will be presented to you for your signature, a cash payment of the adoption fee will occur at this time. The Adoption Agreement is a separate document and covers the stipulations of the probationary period. During this probationary period, if you and your family decide that the adoption is not going to work you, you can return the bird to Greyhaven for a full refund of the adoption fee, less the \$10.00 application fee to cover administration costs. Once the probationary period is over and the adoption has been finalized, the adoption fee is non-refundable.
